Principal's Message

As a soggy and wet November comes to a close, we have completed very busy month and move into a short and busy last few weeks before Winter Break.

Having 27 days of rain this month has made the drainage issue with our grass field very evident. Working with our PAC Executive, we are meeting next week with a school district representative to explore ways to address this ongoing challenge. When areas of the field are flooded and unsafe, the field is closed to student use.

This month we had a student organized Remembrance Day service that was attended by many parents. Many classes actively participated in the program and all divisions were involved in class based learning activities. The school also made a donation to the Billy Bishop Legion Poppy Fund. As well this month, many classes went on field trips to such locations as Victoria, the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra, Ballet BC, Museum of Vancouver, Origins Parkour, Maritime Museum, The Hive Bouldering Gym, Stanley Park, UBC Botanical Garden, Mossom Creek Hatchery and McMillan Space Centre. The Vancouver Fire Department's "Fire Safety House", Unique Minds Learning and the SPCA presented programs in the school.

December promises to be a busy month with choir performances, a PAC Fair, Winter Concert, field trips and a school wide dance program. Term 1 report cards will be issued on December 22, the final day of school before Winter Break.

With all the rain and challenges with our field, combined with a lack of space for use on rainy days, students are often expected to be outside at recess and lunch regardless of the weather. While there are some lunch hour activities and a recess option for Kindergarten and Grade 1 students, it is important for students to come prepared to be outside. A set of dry socks and shoes are highly recommended especially for our primary students.

As you have undoubtedly heard through the media, there is a shortage of substitute teachers and Student Support Workers. At Hudson, there have been several occasions where Resource Teachers have been reassigned to cover enrolling classrooms and Student Support Workers have been reassigned during the day. Resource Teacher service has been affected and some of our special needs students have had changes to their support schedules. I am hopeful that recent and ongoing staff recruitment efforts by the District will alleviate this issue.
