British Columbia Students

Exceptions: students who are classified as International pay the International fee.

International Students

The BC Ministry of Education requires a valid BC issued Personal Education Number (PEN) to fund summer school students. However, students currently attending BC or Canadian schools who are designated as International Students are required to pay International fees.

Additionally, the following students are required to pay International fees for Summer School:

- Students who reside in BC but whose parents do not normally reside in BC
- Students who do not normally reside in BC, even if their parents reside in BC.

Out Of Province Students

The BC Ministry of Education requires a valid BC issued Personal Education Number (PEN) to fund Summer School students. Students who live in Canada, are not BC residents, and who are not International students, are required to pay the "Out Of Province" fee.

Withdrawal / Refund Policy:

Ministry Funded course - If you are not able to attend a course that you have registered in, you must immediately contact our summer school office to withdraw from the course.

Fee-paying course - A \$30 administrative fee will be charged for all withdrawals or transfers from a course for any reason. No tuition refund will be issued after the first day of class.

International Student / Out of Province Student - No tuition refund will be issued for withdrawal for any reason once registered. A \$100 administrative transfer fee will be charged for transferring from one class to another if space is available.
