#### Welcome and Introductions

We recognize that we are gathered in the unceded territory of the Skxwú7mesh [Squamish], xwməθkwəyəm [Musqueam], and səlilw ətaʔɨ [Tsleil-Waututh] peoples. We acknowledge that Henry Hudson Elementary is just over 100 metres from the lands and village site of Sen'ákw orsən'a?qw [pronounced Senawk] from which Squamish people were sent away by illegally forcing them to sell their land in 1913, the year after Hudson was completed.

#### Seismic Upgrade Update

• A Seismic Advisory Group (SAG) meeting was held on October 14 where it was shown they have been making progress on the design. The designs are looking quite good. A lot of the concerns raised have been addressed in updated design, but there are still some areas of concern (ex: teachers have requested storage space). Funds were committed for the design of the 6 extra classrooms, but there is no guarantee they will be built. A 2<sup>nd</sup> tender has been put out for the build of them. All existing furniture is expected to move. Not aware of any fundraising needs from PAC yet. The more advance notice we have, the more forward planning we will have

## Principal Update

- Library news: are processing some new books. They have a lot of novels, but are looking to build the early learning and non-fiction resources. Lynne asked to be invited to the next PAC Executive meeting to see if we can adjust the current budget to reflect this year's needs. Book exchange is up and running. Some classrooms have been participating in VPL workshops, book talks, virtual authors, collaborative work with teachers and students and supporting novel studies. Soon we will be showcasing art and the love of stories in the library
