### 2. General Updates - LINK

Speaker: Doug Roch

- Phase 1: Building complete, except daycare.
- Phase 3: Addition to school started.
  - Changes to outside landscape with new plans.
  - Timeline TBD, anticipated summer 2025.
- Phase 2: Outside area.
  - Bench installation delayed.
  - Three more picnic tables to be added.
  - Four tables to be moved to the back.
  - Shorter fencing in front, obstacles like rocks.
  - SW corner roots and mud area reconsideration.
  - o Timeline TBD, anticipated summer 2025.
  - Demolition occurring now.
  - Field:
    - Gravel field discussed; grass not feasible due to water table.
    - Grass not viable due to maintenance and cost.
    - Full fields at other sites show no significant increase in injuries.
    - Gravel fields are open all the time, easy to maintain, and cost-effective.

Lines for sports to be added quickly and easy maintenance.

#### Q&A:

- Paint durability: Grounds need occasional repainting.
- Accessibility of gravel: Confirmed accessible.
- Long jump pit included in plans smaller kids can dig in the pit
- Similar designs at Fleming and Queen Mary.

## Playground:

- Old playground not salvageable.
- New playground to be installed south of courtyard.
- Funding from district uncertain for new playground.
- Corporate sponsorship policy allows donor recognition signs.

#### Q&A:

- Donation process: Through VSB to PAC.
- Examples: Simon Fraser (\$216,000), Tenneson (\$139,000), DLG (\$105,000).
- Cost increase: Approximately 20%.
- VSB coverage: No specific amount.
- Donation methods: Various options available.
- Playground warranty: Asset of the school.
- **Swings:** Not enough clearance; saucer swing possible.
- Habitat contactor is first choice of district: Possible they could incorporate old playground with new design and keep old warranty on the playground.

- Ground crew: Ready to maintain gravel.
- Turf rental costs: Collaboration with parks board for larger fields is possible.

- Plan to spend \$5,000 surplus immediately for student benefits.

  - Lunch arrangements: Eating in classrooms, staggered schedules for outside/gym play.
  - New lunch programs: Quiet club (Tuesdays) and board game club (Fridays).
  - Entrance safety: Efforts to increase fence height and extend crossing light duration underway.
  - Field trips: Ongoing to kits playground.
