#### Indigenous games share

Parents were given the change to try playing some of the Indigenous games which are part of the school's efforts to share Indigenous ways of knowing and learning.

#### Growing Readers Program

- Ms Robinson shared an updated on the growing reader's program
- Started three years ago to help students who need additional support with reading
- 12 teachers work with the kids on Mondays and Tuesdays
- Grades 1-4 skills foundations
- Phonics skills, reading skills, and comprehension
- Each day ends with a game (gamification enhances learnings)
- Resource teacher are involved for additional lessons, activities that support motor skills (ex pass through a hula hoop without touching the sides)
- Kahoot games on last day treats etc
- Program has proved successful with positive feedback shared from parents of participating kids - students are also enjoying

Teacher Jolene Dosch

- Indigenous learning
- Coast Salish weaving VSB knowledge keeper, Tracy Healy
- Quarter bags created in response to outlawing of Potlaches (way to share things when coming together but hidden)
- Fabric is made from hair of breed of wooly dog (learn about creatures)
- Kids are learning about weaving, algorithmic thinking through patterns
- Growing patterns weaving of this type can be linked with mathematic equations
- Reading materials are available in the glass case in the lobby

Potential for future activities - Knowledge keeper that focuses on music

- Questions Would be great to have joint sessions with parents
  - June setting up a loom that could be done by anyone
- Question Any chance that there could be a learning opportunity for local Indigenous languages

• School team will take away for consideration

## Summer camp

- Update on status many parents were not successful in getting their kids into the summer program
- Kelly will be sending an update to parents on the current situation
- 45-50 spots available 100 applications on day 1

For comparison - after school care has 80 full time spots - 135+ when including part time
