## **Traffic and Safety**

Following last year's meeting on school property with two city councillors, and a follow up with city engineers, we were pleased to hear that city will be increasing the duration for the north south crossing light at Maple & Cornwall. The city will also be doing a traffic study to determine the feasibility of a pedestrian crosswalk at the corner of Walnut & Cornwall. We'll be sure to keep you updated on further information. In the meantime, we recommend continued use of the light at the intersections of Maple or Cypress when crossing Cornwall.

## **Immersion Program Sunset**

Some parents may be aware the students in this year's grad 6 immersion class was the last cohort of the now sunset immersion program at Henry Hudson. The VSB had previously committed to offering the program to students through to graduation age, however parents of this cohort were advised late in 2025 that unfortunately the program would end this year. The parents of these students are working hard to get answers on the shift in position and would appreciate the community's support in sharing our concerns with the VSB on their planned cancellation of the program early. In the meantime, please find below is a note from the parents, with a request for support.

*Dear Henry Hudson families,*

*We are reaching out to ask for your support for a small group of Grade 6 students in our French Immersion program who have been told they will not be able to complete Grade 7 at Henry Hudson.*

*These children are part of our school community, for many it is their catchment school. They have grown up alongside our kids, shared classrooms, assemblies, and friendships.*

*Parents are seeking a one-year, time-limited solution so this cohort can finish Grade 7 French Immersion at their home school. We have drafted a letter you can use or you can send your own letter of support to the trustees. This makes a real difference and helps show that this is a community issue, not just a program issue. Thank you for standing with our students and families.*
